

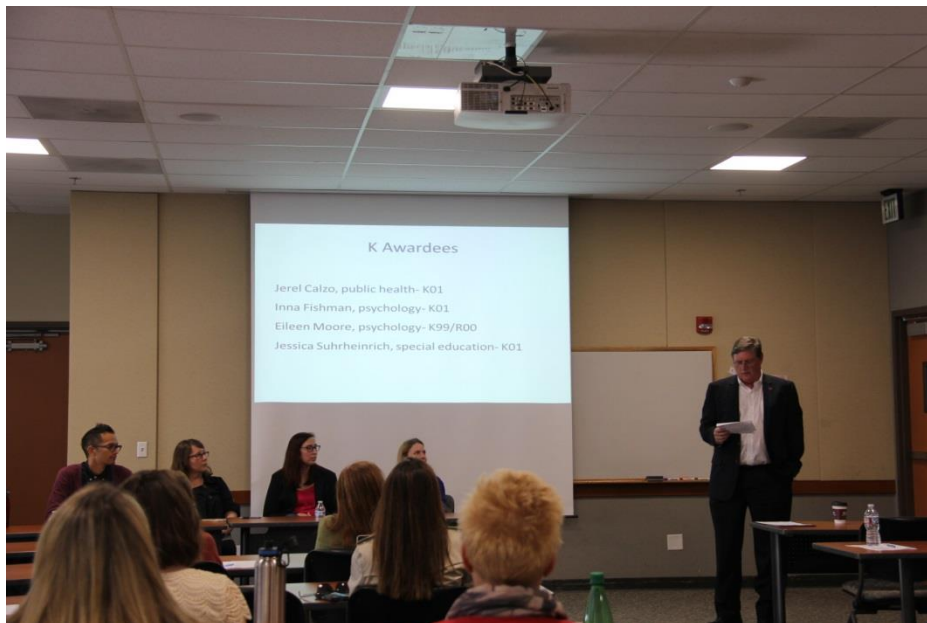
NIH K Award Workshop: Tips from the Experts

Tips

Talk to your program officer (early and often).

Obtain and review funded K proposals.

Choose strong mentors with funding history and K award supervision experience.

Develop a strong training plan – and tie it to the research plan.

Start the process early.
