If it doesn't require an in-person medical exam, you may be able to address it with a doctor using a video visit through the Kaiser Permanente application (App) on your smart phone or tablet.

Some examples of possible symptoms:

- Cough/Cold
- Sore Throat
- Vomiting
- Eye Problem
- Diarrhea
- Skin Problem
- Follow up Visits

When you call us, we will:

- Confirm you've had at least one face-to-face visit with us
- Make sure you have a symptom that can be treated via video visit
- Make sure you have a smart phone or tablet with a front facing camera and the Kaiser Permanente Mobile Application
